ENGAGEMENT OF INTERNMEDICAL OFFICERS JUNE 2020
INTAKE 2011/2012 (REPEAT BATCH)

1. The following Medical Graduates will be engaged as Intern Medical Officers in the Department of Health Services with effect from 22.06.2020 to enable them to qualify for registration as Medical Practitioners in terms of the Medical Ordinance. Kindly note that two six monthly appointments need to be done.
2. These Officers should be paid the allowance as indicated in General Circulars No.03/2016 dated 25/02/2016. They should be provided with accommodation free of charge.
3. Their Internship will be terminated if their work and conduct during this period is found unsatisfactory. They will be required to abide by the Regulations, of the Establishment Code, the Financial Regulations, the Departmental Rules & Regulations, and Regulations of the Government and the orders of the Department of Health Services that may be issued from time to time. Private Practice in any form is strictly prohibited to the Intern Medical Officers.
4. Intern Medical Officers are not entitled to any paid leave. Leave is restricted to 14 days of which not more than two days should be taken at a time, except in the case of illness. If leave for more than 14 days is availed of the relevant appointment must be repeated in full unless the excess period is covered by a medical certificate and approved by the Sri Lanka Medical Council. If for any reason the period of Internship of an Intern is extended, that Intern is not entitled to any emoluments during that period.
5. Intern Medical Officers should have white overcoats with them for use. Head of Institutions are required to ensure that white coats are worn by the Intern Medical Officers while attending clinical duties.

6. They should report to the Head of the Institution to which they are posted by 8.00 a.m. on the first day of the commencement of their Intern appointments.
7. Intern Medical Officers are entitled to obtain second class railway warrants (for the Officer only from a Medical Institution closest to him/her to travel to the station in which he/she is to serve. Such warrants will be issued on the production of this letter.
8. The date of assumption of duties by these officers should be reported to this office through Health 373 form.
9. Medical Officers with foreign qualifications are appointed under section 31 of the Medical Ordinance.
