### **Background of the project**

Cervical cancer is one of the gravest threats to women's lives. Without urgent attension, deaths due to cervical cancer are projected to rise by almost 25% over the next 10 years. Cervical cancer is the second commonest neoplasm among women in Sri Lanka causing 850 number of deaths annually and it is caused by the persistent infection from high risk genotypes 16 and 18 of HPV. The prevalence of HPV in the actual population among women is 3.3%.
