Annual Transfer of Grade Dental Surgeons 2020- Stage I Final Results (Pending PSC Approval) and Calling for Applications for Stage II

Stage I Final Results (Pending PSC Approval)

Stage I - Annual Transfers of Grade Dental Surgeons 2020 has been finalised after considering the appeals and awaiting the approval of the Health Service Committee (HSC) of the Public Service Commission (PSC). The list is published in the website of Ministry of Health, Nutrition and Indigenous Medicine for the information of applicants. Please note that this is not the Transfer Order and no any observation or appeals will be entertained regarding this list. Once the HSC of the PSC approval is obtained, it will be notified immediately to implement transfers. Until such time, officers are advised not to move from their respective stations.

Application for Stage II

All the officers are advised to read carefully and comprehend the contents of this notice before applying for stage II of the Annual Transfers 2020.

This is further to the communications published on the official website of the Ministry of Health and Medical Services with even numbered notices D/DS/AT/164/2019 dated 19.09.2019, 23.10.2019 and 02.12.2019.

The noted and eligible lists (Annexure I), Existing vacancies (Annexure II), Newly added vacancies due to PGIM release (Annexure III), Vacancies changed (Annexure IV), Vacancies removed (Annexure V), New stations (Annexure VI) and the Vacancies of special posts unfilled in stage I (Annexure VII) are attached herewith.

- All the noted dental surgeons, except who received a post in Annual Transfer of Grade Dental Surgeons 2020- Stage I, should apply for Stage II of Annual transfer. If no application received from such officers, they are liable to be appointed to any vacant station on the discretion of Transfer board.
- 2. All the relevant dental surgeons should apply only through the web based online application appeared on http://dental.hrmis.health.gov.lk/ on or before 23/92/2020. Applicants are kindly requested to send certified hard copy with relevant documentary proof of seniority (grade 1 promotion letter, confirmation letter) through the proper channel.
- 3. Those who are eligible for transfers also may apply for the Stage II of Annual transfer. Stations of the eligible posts may fall vacant as the current incumbent may selected for their preferred post. The noted and eligible officers who are interested of applying for those potentially vacant posts may do so.
- 4. Transfers will be carried only according to grade seniority.
- 5. All the Dental Surgeons in the noted list and the eligible list will be first assigned to the stations on their preferences and thereafter noted applicants who are not indicating adequate preferences will be assigned on the discretion of Transfer board.
- 6. The officers who have been allocated stations in stage I will not be considered for the stations in stage II.
- 7. To apply to a previous station, the officer has to be away from the particular station minimum of 2 years.
- 8. Any dental surgeon irrespective of their previous transfer orders may apply for newly introduced stations. (Annexure VI)
- 9. Seniority of the officer will be considered on letters from the Public Service Commission dated prior to 18.12.2019 (closing date of Stage I application) on grade promotion and confirmation, for preparation of the seniority rank.
- 10. The functioning clinics without the formal cadre approval, were advertised utilizing formally approved cadre of another institution within the same RDHS division.

Criteria based posts

1. Post of RDS

The Dental surgeons selected to the RDS post have to work in supervisory capacity related to technical and managerial issues in the field of dentistry in the region. Applicants should be confirmed in services with 10 years service experience to be eligible to apply for RDS posts. Preference will be given to those who possess Post Graduate Qualifications as per para 7.2 of Medical Services Minute. If there are no applicants with eligibility criteria the station will be allocated on temporary grounds for one year.

2. SHO/HO Posts and Dental Surgeons in Specialized Units of Dental Services

The posts that were unfilled in Stage I are open to Stage II and will be allocated on applicants based on seniority. However, these posts cannot be considered as a special post in the future annual transfers

3. Officers selected for MOH office have to abide by the Health Programmes conducting in relevant MOH areas apart from routine Dental practice
